



The Campbelltown Golf Club Advisory Committee (CGCAC) has formulated a slow play policy which has been distributed through the Pro Shop and placed on noticeboards in the Club House as well as in the fixture book.

The purpose of this Policy is for the Membership to self-regulate their games in order to avoid any slow play penalties.

- Ensure your group is ready to tee off at least 15 minutes prior to your allocated tee time.
- Always be aware of your place in the field. This is DIRECTLY behind the group you are following.
- Walk to your ball quickly and be ready to play your shot.
- Where possible, position your equipment behind or to the side of the green, under no circumstances leave your equipment in front of the green.
- Clear the green as quickly as possible and mark your card when appropriate to do so.
- In Stableford and Par events you must pick up when you cannot score on the hole.
- Play a provisional ball at all times when you are not sure whether your ball has entered a hazard or out of bounds or you believe it may be hard to find.
- Time recording is **COMPULSORY**. Failure to comply will incur penalties.

The penalties below will be imposed on ALL players in the group not just the individual. All penalties are the discretion of the CGCAC.
